- Professors like XS classes because...
 It reinforces what students learn in their classroom.
- Students sign up via MIDREC from their Adviser, or in person at the Academic Center
- Classes meet once per week for specific STEM course

Midshipmen Group Study Program

- Peer tutoring and group study facilitated by MGSP Leaders

 - Walk-in only
- Dozens of courses offered
 - ~140 volunteer MGSP Leaders for this coming Fall
 - Writing Center peer tutors also available
- MGSP Leaders
 - Work closely with their paired faculty for their course
 - Receive credit via DM301 course
 - Leaders are trained by the Academic Center in collaborative learning techniques and study strategies



 - 1048 Midshipmen





Total Academic Center Visits 2008 - 2015




Unique MIDN Visiting Academic Center 2008 - 2015
