Alumni Mentoring Program (AMP)

The Alumni Mentoring Program was established as the 50th Legacy Gift of the Class of 1969 to promote the USNA culture of Alumni helping Alumni to achieve "the highest responsibilities of command, citizenship and government." AMP was approved as an on-going offering of the Alumni Association by the USNAAA Board of Trustees at its May 2014 meeting.

How It Works

Alumni from all USNA classes may join AMP and engage in mentoring as protégés, mentors or both. Protégés match with mentors through an online platform and begin mentoring relationships, customized by each protégémentor pair for their specific circumstance. Mentors help protégés set higher goals, achieve more and be happier.

Each protégé has unique objectives and goals that will determine the depth and duration of the mentoring relationship, which can range from a brief engagement on a discrete topic to a lifelong relationship. Mentors offer insights from their backgrounds and experiences to support protégé goals and objectives. Mentoring pairs may meet in person, use email, telephone, Skype or other online meeting tools to communicate. Mentoring relationships can be terminated at any time by either participant for any reason. Participants may engage in multiple, concurrent pairings and all program activities are private and confidential.

AMP provides a library of tools and resources to support successful and meaningful mentoring outcomes, including guides specifically developed for USNA Alumni. Participants can also connect and share memories, knowledge and information through AMP's online chat boards.

Mentoring is a way to give back and to experience the gratification that comes from helping fellow Alumni achieve greater success. Mentors share, teach and expand the mind to imagine what is possible. Protégés gain valuable insight, wisdom and advice from Alumni Mentors who have "been there, done that."
